Job Announcement

Two-year postdoctoral fellowship at INAF- OAS (Osservatorio di Astrofisica e Scienza dello Spazio di Bologna) on:

Scientific exploitation of X-ray AGN surveys and study of survey strategies for new X-ray missions concepts.

Research Project

The successful candidate will join the extragalactic X-ray group in Bologna and investigate the demography and cosmological evolution of AGN by means of X-ray surveys. He/she will also perform feasibility studies of AGN surveys by future X-ray missions. In particular he/she will simulate and devise observing strategies for mission concepts featuring large X-ray collecting areas that can be achieved through segmented mirror technology (STAR-X, AXIS, ...).

Eligibility

Preference will be given to young researchers who obtained a PhD degree in Physics or Astronomy in the year 2014 or later. Previous experience on X-ray AGN surveys, multi-band source catalogs, and demography and evolution of AGN will be an advantage. Good knowledge of English is required.

The appointment is expected to begin between February and June 2019, and will be for two years in the first instance, and renewable afterwards, subject to funding availability and performance review. The net monthly salary is around 2,400 Euros.

- 4) a list of scientific publications that are relevant for the fellowship (optionally attach copy of those not listed on ADS);
- 5) any other work or publication the applicant deems useful;
- 6) a list of all presented documents.

Each of the above documents must be signed and dated. Note that the application will be rejected if incomplete and/or unsigned.
